PHRONTISTERY

“EVERY MAN’S CONSCIENCE  
IS HIS OWN HANGMAN!”

And in order to escape the sense of guilt that they have, they flock to Communism which denies all personal guilt. The only kind of guilt there is from Communism, is the guilt of someone else. There is not even wanting a certain type of social reformer, who will become interested in the reformation of society in order to take his conscience off his own guilt.” [Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen]

Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen meant that inner guilt naturally punishes the human soul, and people often try to escape this self-inflicted torment by blaming society or joining collective movements that deny personal accountability.

This explains why guilt-ridden people blame society instead of themselves.

- ✙ No self-discipline = No self-worth;
- ✙ No self-worth = No self-responsibility;
- ✙ No self-responsibility = No obligation for one’s own actions;
- ✙ No obligation for one’s own actions = guilting of others for one’s own faults and failings.

The Meaning of the Quote

- ✙ **Inescapable Guilt:** Sheen taught that an unburdened or unrepentant conscience creates deep psychological and spiritual distress.
- ✙ **The Internal Judge:** Just as a hangman executes a sentence, a person’s own moral awareness inflicts internal punishment for wrongdoing.

How People Try to Escape It

- ✙ **Shifting Blame:** Instead of seeking personal forgiveness or facing moral truth, individuals try to quiet their conscience.
- ✙ **Collective Ideologies:** Sheen argued that people sometimes lean on political systems or mass movements—such as rigid collectivism—that deny individual responsibility and place fault entirely on society or outside forces.
- ✙ **Reforming Others:** Some act as social reformers not out of pure charity, but to distract from their own hidden guilt by trying to fix the outer world instead of their own heart.

The Proposed Remedy

- ✙ Sheen maintained that mental anguish caused by hidden guilt cannot be permanently cured by rationalizing sin away.
- ✙ He pointed instead to personal accountability, humility, and spiritual reconciliation (*such as confession*) to truly lift the weight of a troubled conscience.

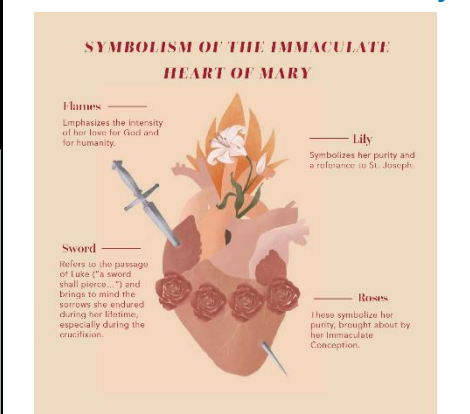

MONTHLY DEVOTION

The Immaculate Heart of Mary



The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her Divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart.

On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn **Act of Consecration of the Church and the Whole World to the Immaculate Heart**. (see left panel).

Our very consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary calls upon us to make reparation for the offenses that we and others have committed against her.

The Church, in inviting us to consecrate ourselves to her Immaculate Heart, implicitly calls upon us for this reparation. But more explicitly, and even before Fatima, Saint Pius X offered a plenary indulgence to all who, on the first Saturday of the month, would observe special devotions in honor of the Immaculate Virgin in a spirit of reparation for the blasphemies uttered against her.

There is, however, an even more basic reason why each one of us owes reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary: every sin of ours caused grief and suffering to her in union with her Divine Son.

For sin was the cause of that terrible day on Calvary when she, as the New Eve, shared in the torment of the great sacrifice, and, amidst indescribable pain, brought forth spiritually all the members of the Mystical Body of her divine Son.

God willed that Mary should be intimately associated with His Son in bearing the burden of all sin; surely then, her Immaculate Heart, in union with His divine Heart, should receive reparation from us who have caused them such pain.

If anyone causes hurt to even a very ordinary human being, he does not overlook the need to make amends. How much more do we owe to the Hearts of Jesus and Mary!

Into Great Silence

Nestled deep in the postcard-perfect French Alps, the Grande Chartreuse is considered one of the world’s most ascetic monasteries. In 1984, German filmmaker Philip Gröning wrote to the Carthusian order for permission to make a documentary about them. They said they would get back to him. Sixteen years later, they were ready. Gröning, sans crew or artificial lighting, lived in the monks’ quarters for six months—filming their daily prayers, tasks, rituals and rare outdoor excursions. This transcendent, closely observed film seeks to embody a monastery, rather than simply depict one—it has no score, no voiceover and no archival footage. What remains is stunningly elemental: time, space and light. One of the most mesmerizing and poetic chronicles of spirituality ever created, INTO GREAT SILENCE dissolves the border between screen and audience with a total immersion into the hush of monastic life. More meditation than documentary, it’s a rare, transformative theatrical experience for all.

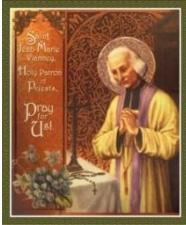

SOLEMN SUNG HOLY MASS
